You are all being asked to vote for the Scorer who would be a worthy recipient of the Derek Hibbs Award. The important points you have to consider are: - The **Scorer of the Year** should –

- Observe good time keeping prior to and during the match.
- Have a good knowledge of relevant laws and any match regulations.
- Have all necessary items of equipment with him/her to properly carry out their duties.
- Accept instructions given by the Umpires and immediately and clearly acknowledge all umpires' signals including individual acknowledgement of multiple signals.
- Maintain a clear and accurate scoring record of the match including frequently checking with their Colleague that the records agree.
- Agree with the Umpires at each interval, other than a drinks interval, and at the conclusion of the match, the runs scored, the wickets that have fallen and, where appropriate, the overs bowled.

The person who is to be Scorer of the Year will require all these qualities and more.

The award will be determined solely by the votes from the active member Umpires & Scorers. You are to make your selection only from those Scorers who officiated an entire match for a Gloucestershire Club or Cricket Body and who either was your Colleague at the game or who scored the match in which you were an umpire.

Your selection **does not** necessarily have to be members of the Gloucestershire Association of Cricket Umpires and Scorers. Please place your nomination in the box below then sign and date the form.
